Science:

Animals and their skeletons:

Through this unit, the children will:

*identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat

*identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Sound:

Through this unit, the children will:

*identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating

*recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear

*find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it

*find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it

*recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

Computing:

In computing we will be drawing and desktop publishing to make our own persuasive posters. In the second half of the Summer term we will be programming, and looking at creating and debugging algorithms
