English:

This term in English we will be developing our writing skills using the books 'Toys in Space' and 'Goldilocks and Just One Bear'. In our guided reading sessions, the Year 2s will be reading 'The Bear and The Piano' and 'Nibbles the Dinosaur Guide. The Year 1s will follow the guided reading in the Rising Stars Phonics scheme.

Geography:

This term in Geography we will thinking about "Where do we live?'. We will explore the human and physical features of our local area. We will develop our fieldwork and observational study skills. We will also look at maps of our local area and identify features of maps. We will also look at homes, businesses, and jobs in the local area and how our local area links to the wider world.

Computing:

This term in Computing we will be learning about 'IT Around Us'. We will develop their understanding of what information technology (IT) is and will begin to identify examples. They will discuss where they have seen IT in school and beyond, in settings such as shops, hospitals, and libraries. Learners will then investigate how IT improves our world, and they will learn about the importance of using IT responsibly.

Maths:

This term in Maths the Year 1s will be learning about Place Value (within 20), Addition & Subtraction (within 20, including recognising money) and Place Value & Multiplication (within 50). The Year 2s will be learning about Place Value (numbers to 200), Addition & Subtraction (within 100 including money) and Multiplication.

Knowing me, Knowing you

History:

This term we will be thinking about 'How have we changed over time?'. We will be developing an understanding of the past, exploring chronological order within their lives and those in living memory of family members. We will compare homes and ways of life now with those from the past, we will also compare the life of a child with that of a child in the past. We will also be exploring Black History, through the lives of Rosa Parks and Harriet Tubman.

Art and Design & Technology:

This term in Art we will be looking at self-portraits. We will explore a range of materials for drawing and painting, look at self-portraits by famous artists and use different tools and techniques to create their own self-portraits. This term in D&T we will de designing and making a healthy meal. We will explore a range of fruit and vegetables, understand basic food hygiene, use hand tools and learn food processing skills e.g., cutting, grating, slicing.

Science:

This term in Science we will be learning about Animals. We will explore the human body, think about different animal groups and their characteristics, identify animal body parts, we will discuss how humans grow and think about and observe how life starts for different animals and what happens to them as they grow. We will also be investigating our environment and we will study how our surroundings change throughout the year and through the different seasons

PE:

This term in PE we will be developing our skills in gymnastics, dance and practising our bat and ball skills through multi-sports activities.

RE:

This term in RE we will be exploring the questions; 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' And 'Who is Muslim and how do they live?'

PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be learning about 'Relationships'. We will think about what makes a good friend and how to be a good listener. Anti-bullying week also takes place from Monday 13th November - Friday 17th November. This year's theme is 'Make A Noise About Bullying'
