Science:

In Science this term we will be studying two topics; sound and animals and their skeletons. In the sound unit pupils listen to and identify sounds and learn how our ears work to detect sounds. They carry out experiments to help them learn about loudness and pitch.

Art:

This term we will explore a rainforest theme by creating colourful prints inspired by the plants and animals found there. We will also look at the work of Andy Warhol and use his bold, repeated printing style to design our own artwork.

Computing:

During the first half of the term, we will be learning about creating media and photo editing. Learners will develop their understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be re-saved and reused. They will consider the impact that editing images can have, and evaluate the effectiveness of their choices. In the second half, we will be learning about copy right and ownership. This unit helps children understand that the things they create (like drawings, photos, or writing) belong to them, and that other people's work belongs to those creators too. online.

Our Topic Is... *Hot and Cold*

Geography/History:

This term we will be focusing on Geography. Or overall title for this unit is Hot and Cold places. During this unit, pupils explore different places around the world, comparing their own village with hot and cold locations such as Chiapas and Mexiquillo in Mexico, and Sicily and the Aosta Valley in Italy. They learn about global biomes, climate zones, types of settlement, land use, economic activity, and natural resources. Pupils then apply this knowledge to their local area, investigating why people settled here and how settlement has shaped the environment.

D&T:

This term in DT the children we will be looking at pneumatics. In this project children use pneumatics to design and make a mascot .The children explore the nature of pneumatic systems and how these can be incorporated into a design for a mascot, which they then make and evaluate.

PE:

PE sessions will be on a Tuesday this term with Miss Woodhouse. This term there will be swimming on Friday's, please see your letter that details when your child's lesson will be (Either first half term or second). When not swimming PE lessons will be in place.

French:

Weekly session with Mrs Maund every Tuesday.

R.E:

During the first half of this term in RE we are going to be answering the key question, ' How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jews? 'This unit explores the importance of the family and home in Judaism. In the second half of term we will be answering the key question' How and why do people try to make the world a better place?' children will be given the opportunity to compare ways in which Christians, Jews, Muslims and non-religious people make a difference, and also making connections with pupils' experiences.

Music:

Weekly music lesson and Key Stage 2 singing session with Shropshire Music Service teacher on a Wednesday. Mrs Kessel-Fell will teach year 3 recorders and Mrs Nowotarski will teach year 4 violin!

PSHE:

In PSHE we will be focusing on Health and Wellbeing. This will focus on the following areas: Healthy Lifestyles, Growing and changing Finally, during the second half of term, we will be covering work from our RSE (Relationships and Sex Education) unit using Shropshire's Shropshire Respect Yourself: Eat Better, Move More, RSE programme
